



Crisis: Great Britain

NOTE TO ALL NUNO DELEGATES: *These are the character descriptions for all NUNO delegates. Each delegate is assigned to one of the 25 characters listed below. Each delegate must represent their character's belief regarding the current crisis during the committee, unless told otherwise by the head chair of their designated committee. Delegates will use the description of their characters to write a portion of their position paper and construct their opening speech(es) during conference. Delegates are only required to read their own character's description. Also, delegates should note that these characters completely are fictional, and any resemblance or similarities to any real life figure is strictly coincidental.*

IV. Character Descriptions

Kade Royal -

Kade is a former member of the England army and retired veteran. He has seen the tragedies of war and what it can do to men. He was a part of the Third Anglo-Afghan War which Britain lost; Kade saw many of his brothers fall down dead next to him and has become a devout pacifist ever since. Opposing the Great War from the start, Kade is a renowned activist in ending the conflict before anyone else can die. Though his following is relatively small for the population of Britain, his presence is still a thorn in the side of many politicians and pro-war people alike.

Braden Murphy -

Braden is a masterclass chef in Scotland. Since this is a joint meeting between Ireland, Wales, Scotland, and England, he decided to make the long venture to The City of London to express his extremist pro war ideology. As a hater of the Germans, Braden believes that they should be destroyed and that the country of Great Britain needs to conquer as much German land as possible.



He has been a long time donor to the British Royal Navy in hopes that his efforts could help see the Germans destroyed and abolished.

Jared Jaxon -

Jared is an aspiring musician in London with hopes to breakthrough and make a name for himself. Though he has not yet signed a record deal yet, he is close to hitting it big. He tries to use his music to express his ideals of peace, love, and prosperity. Though he is not necessarily a German sympathiser, he is not for war because he believes that the international community should all cooperate to make the idea of “world peace” a reality. The request for an armistice by the Germans must be accepted as soon as possible by Great Britain, and hopefully France and the United States will follow suit.

Morris Frankie -

His family is of German descent and emigrated to England nearly 60 years ago. This proud family history to Deutschland causes him to be a sympathiser to German society, but not their government. Seeing this as a war against the Kaiser and not the people, he believes that a peaceful solution to the war can be reached, possibly by trading or placing high tariffs on the countries still doing business with the Germans. All out war and destruction is a last resort to Morris, but not out of the question because it is for the safety of his new friends and all of Europe. He would want to take the shores of the Northern territories of Germany first before moving further central into German occupied territories.



Milo Glanville -

Milo is homeless, plain and simple. In a time where morale for the homeless was at a near low, he is unemployed in a time of a great industry boom and war, but not enlisted. He has to beg on the streets and only made it to this council in London accidentally by him stumbling inside during the harsh rain. Since all votes in the council are equal, he means just as much as anyone else in the room, he just might not have as much pulling power in straight up convincing people by persuasive diction or bribes. Milo is a peace-maker though and hopes that it would be possible to end the war on all fronts. Obviously he supports his own country of England and hopes for them to win if the war must go on, but would prefer a peace summit between all the countries to end the conflict.

Cy Palmer -

Cy Palmer is one of the greatest rugby players of his generation. His team, the Shale Sharks, got second to the league after he suffered a career ending fracture to his right thumb.

He has since tried to pick up politics in his hometown of Manchester. After running for MP of the greater Manchester Area and failing, he decided to become a local activist. Palmer is a strong believer that the war economy is a good economy. Though it will not and can not last forever, war is good for business and thus good for Manchester. Having the war last longer will cause the British to need more uniforms which are all manufactured in Manchester. However, the air force is what brings in the most revenue.. almost 15% of all economic profit in Manchester has to deal with the British Air Force. For these reasons, Palmer hopes to utilize these forces the most in the war.

Harry Henry -



Harry is a local shoe-maker and shiner. He has been in the Parliament building for over 30 years. His long experience has led him to gain a little bit of dirt on every MP in the country. 650 of the most powerful people in the country all could be summed up in a scandal because of a file he has on his “friends”. This lead Henry to gain great influence over Parliament and would like to send boots on the ground for the battle. Henry believes that boots on the ground are the most effective way to fight the tyrannical Germans head on. If possible, Henry believes that Germany should claim territory and colonize in Germany to expand economic markets and extract natural resources from Germany. The best place to approach, and attempt to colonize Germany is going by sea through to the northwestern part of Germany and using ground troops from there to truly gain a foothold in the nation.

Lincoln Parker -

The weasel. Lincoln is known to be an all out hustler. He will do what he needs to for the betterment of himself and never for others. If the war could get him drafted he is against it, if not, all for because of the growth of his business. He has used his “ill-gotten gains” to advance his hustle: through lying, cheating, and selling overpriced goods he has made a reputation of being untrustworthy. As a smooth talker he will try to find any way necessary to advance his position. He is currently for the idea of an all out assault on the Germans, as long as there is no draft which could cause him or any of his loved ones to be enlisted.

Adrian Tiger -



A tiger keeper in the London Zoo; Adrian has been at his craft for only 2 weeks. The simple fact is that Adrian does not care about the war, he would rather focus on his tigers. He is unsympathetic towards his country and the Germans, just as long as France does not advance. Though he is aware that the British cannot directly attack the French, he wants them destroyed because of their horrible treatment of animals in the France. The enemy of my enemy is my friend so Adrian is willing to pair up with Germany or the US in order to ensure the destruction of the vulgar French people.

Virgil Garey -

Virgil is a fashion designer in Manchester. His clothing line, On-Black, is one of the hottest brands in England. He is very anti-war which has had a negative effect on his business seeing as it is against the popular opinion of the public. His greedy tendencies have led him to silence his opinion recently, because, after all, money talks. Though he could be swayed back to his anti-war tendencies if there was a large enough following, Virgil is “for” the war to keep going and destruction of the German enemy, even if it means sacrificing his own ideology in the process. He wants Great Britain to finish the German job and exterminate the Germans so that the people of Great Britain can be appeased and this war can finally be over and done with.

Zed Green VII -

Zed Green is a simple man, a farmer. Green’s family have been farming in the lower coast of England since William the Conqueror arrived. His family status has given him plenty of prestigious awards from the crown, like meeting the King George V and Queen Mary for tea. Zed, out of respect for his government, has donated lots of money to the navy and even sent his son to



fight for the war cause. He views part of his fiscal responsibility as a citizen is to donate to the cause of the war; therefore, he donates 40% of his annual income to Great Britain's troops. He hopes that his money is primarily sent to the navy, and is used to finish off the Germans in the war, as well as begin the early stages of English colonization in Germany.

Clint Phillip -

Phillip is an arms dealer for the British Army. Obviously, he is for this war. Potentially billions of pounds to be made could make any man for the war. As a master salesman and strategist he has been working hard and diligently. Convincing the ENTIRE committee to go for the war and send as many troops as possible is all he is here for. He is also a lobbyist for the British Parliament to make sure that this war keeps going. He specializes in infantry weapons, more so than naval technology and arms, so he stresses for the annihilation of Germany by use of ground troops. Phillip does not frown upon the use of the British navy as he still reaps profit from their mobilization of his weapons. The war must continue and Great Britain can not under any circumstances accept the request for an armistice from the tyrannical Germans.

Ramsey Sterling -

A silver miner in Northern England, Ramsey is recognised by his peers as a very gruff and introverted man. However, he is willing to do anything to protect his home country, if only for himself. Ramsey understands the threat the Germans pose to the world, but does not want to fight, and believes that violence should strictly be a last resort. Negotiations with the Germans would be the best route of action, so that Great Britain could possibly discuss peace treaty clauses that would



benefit the English people. If he is required to fight, however, he would fight to his very last breath to honor his country that has given him a place to grow up in and become the man that he is today.

Boniface Lester -

Nicknamed “The Bone Doctor”, Boniface Lester is a well-known Britain extremist, and enlisted herself into the war as a private army member, making her very presence in the war illegal.

Well-trained in every firearm currently available, Lester is feared by many, and known by all.

From 1916 and throughout the war, the Central Powers have had a healthy bounty on her head for the capture of Boniface either dead or alive. She will use brute force to fight the Germans, and refuses to take commands from anybody. She believes that the war should be fought until every German is either dead, captured, or has surrendering to the British Army. There is no pride in taking mercy on the tyrannical Germans who have escalated this war for too much.

Blair Shane -

A respected cobbler from London, Blair was enlisted into the British Armed Forces as infantry, and quickly moved up the ranks. Known for his successful strategies, which somehow never seem to fail, Blair was asked to join this conference to provide a strategy to win the war, which is currently to win through espionage. Espionage is a great way to blindside the Germans in their defeat, as well as possibly more German territory than other competing countries. Great Britain infantry should first and foremost decline the German request for an armistice and then wipe Germany off the map. However, Great Britain must also keep in the back of their minds that



France and the United States are their competitors in claiming German land. In essence, Great Britain should put on the facade that they are aligned with its fellow Entente members, even though in actuality there is no nation-state that we can truly trust in this situation.

Parris Trolley -

Living up to her namesake, Parris is somewhat of a social issue. Arrested on multiple accounts of vandalism, thievery, and downright inappropriateness, Parris has no opinion on the current war, and believes it is going to be fruitless. War is a foreign concept to her, and she does not understand that death and pain are a very real thing. She believes that all the quarreling over the war is pointless and that the war should just end so that the citizens of Great Britain can go back to living lives that don't revolve completely around the war. The armistice requested by the German's should just be accepted already and draw a close to the war immediately.

Triana Briony -

Last living descendant of the Briony family, Triana Briony has inherited her family's money, and plans on donating to the war effort. However, because of her lack of needing to work to survive, Briony has little understanding of whom to donate the money to. However she does know enough to believe that investing in armaments and land-based vehicles would be the best course of action, given that the naval strength of the country is already so superior. The only thing that we need to focus on as a nation, is bolstering up our infantry and land-based operations, which will be the most important aspect in this highly land-based conflict that Europe finds itself in today.



Phillipa Dawn -

A member of one of Britain's lowest class, Phillipa Dawn is considered the scum of the earth. Dealing in drugs, weapons, and smuggling illegal immigrants to make ends meet, Dawn's business has boomed ever since German citizens have been trying to escape the war. However, big business comes at a cost. The British Parliament have warned to stop her business unless she questions all of her clients for information regarding the war. Phillipa is a sort of 'black sheep' in this committee and has great disdain for her own government. She does hope the war continues on so she can continue on with her illegal, yet profitable business; however, she hopes in the end that her own intrusive government suffers major losses during the continuation of the war.

Claretta Tahnea -

Maid for the Queen herself, Tahnea is known for being able to ask favors of the Queen without any repercussions. For this reason, she heavily sympathizes with the nation-state of Great Britain, but as a result of her arrogance from being the Queen's Maid, she can be persuaded to help the Germans. This makes her a useful asset to the German Army, and given her German heritage, it is quite possible that she will side with them. However, if she is not feel valued or important to the German operations, she will continue to serve as the maid and not give away any valuable intel to her German mother country.

Grey Meade -

Parris Trolly's right-hand man, Meade is a huge supporter of Germany without actually showing it. He has subtly made subliminal messages in public to gain support for Germany. Mrs. Trolly does



not know his pastime exists, and believes that Grey is a loyal member of “The British-Irish Alliance”. Meade has kept up the act to protect his country, going as far as becoming addicted to Guinness just to play the “generic Irishman” part. He disagrees with Germany’s attempt to try to end this war by way of peaceful armistice, as he believe that the Germans have a great shot in being able to fight for their old land back that is currently up for grabs. All it takes is for the Triple Entente to have minor intra alliance conflict, and the Germans will be able to take advantage, annihilate the Entente, and become the most prominent nation in the world.

Spencer Churchill -

Illegitimate son of the politically active Churchill family, Spencer Churchill is known only to his father, who denies any connection to him. He is 29 and enlisted in the British Air Force, and is nicknamed “Fliegende Angst”, or “Flying Fear” due to his tremendous kill count of 17 aircraft. He believes the Germans had no reason to escalate the war to the extent they did and has an everlasting grudge against them for this. He also is quite disgusted with the idea that the German forces have been able to utilize unethical chemical weapons consistently on defenseless enemies and still go to bed every night. Germans are merciless rats in his eyes. He is considered an extremist by his peers, which has been shown through his aggressiveness on his patrols and missions in the air.

Nicky Nancy -

Confidante and spouse of Spencer Churchill, Nancy is recognized by her peers as somewhat of an outcast. She believes the war will be fruitless, and thus is extremely against Churchill’s



participation in the Royal Air Force. To this extent she will try forever to keep him from fighting in the sky, even going as far as treason if need be. This means she would help the Germans or any nation-state to keep Spencer alive and out of harm's way, but will leave it as a last resort, knowing how important it is to Spencer that the British succeed and annihilate what he perceives to be the “rats that are the Germans”. She secretly hopes that the German armistice is accepted by Great Britain and the rest of the international community.

Sandra Faith -

A missionary of the Protestant Church, Faith is known by Britain for her outcries against the Germans, preaching that they await judgement by the Protestant God and will be treated as mentioned within “Dante’s Inferno”. Considered somewhat of a loon, the German Army has no respect for her, and multiple attempts have been made to assassinate her for her harsh religious propaganda against the German hierarchy. This has caused her to live in fear of the Germans, and her opinion of the war is for the British to win, but not to do any harm onto the innocent German civilians that do not represent the German tyranny of evil of evil that has transcended over Europe over the past decade.

Jackson Rorry -

A homeless man of the streets, Rorry is the best friend of Milo Glanville, and will side with him for anything. Rorry is against the war, but supports Britain’s point of view in the matter given that he is loyal to his country and his people. This has caused him conflict in the past, as Milo does not believe in fighting, but Jackson believes in necessity of the fight. All methods should be employed



to win, but Rorry believes in utilizing the Royal Fleet to suffocate the Germans to only being able to fight on the land. Cutting off the Germans from the coast will allow them to not make any maritime trades and, undoubtedly, yield a victory for Great Britain and its allies. He hopes that Britain winning the war will show his undevoted nationalism to his motherland, and hopefully thereafter he will have a fresh start for himself and be looked upon as more than just a homeless street dweller.

Ben Foster -

Believed dead by his squadron of old, Foster has not made his presence known to many, and uses the name Ben Foster as an alibi. Nobody knows his real name, and he is very quiet and grave. If asked for his opinion, Foster will stare into space and reply with a thought-out strategy hours after he is asked. His interaction with society is very limited, and as such, Foster has little idea of the current status of the war going on, after suffering a major defeat to the Germans in 1919 and barely making it out alive. He is extremely against the war, and has stated multiple times to his neighbors and peers that the war is only sending young men to die, much like taking pigs to a butcher's shop.
